INDIVIDUALS CAN NOW CHECK OUT FREE ONLINE JOB TRAINING FROM SOUTH PASADENA PUBLIC LIBRARY

[South Pasadena, Calif.] The <u>California State Library</u> recently announced the award of a \$4.366 million <u>American Rescue Plan Act</u> grant to provide libraries across the state access to online job training, skill building, academic and vocational exam prep, and professional development in multiple languages and for a variety of skill levels.

Through this program—<u>CAreer Pathways</u>—individuals in South Pasadena can access Coursera, GetSetUp, LearningExpress, LinkedIn Learning, Northstar, and Skillshare for free until September 30, 2022. These online resources expand the digital workforce platform offerings at South Pasadena Public

Library and allow patrons to visit the website or use the Library's public internet computers to participate in online classes, take practice exams, learn new skills, and more. Access to these platforms normally comes with subscriptions and other fees, but for at least one year through ARPA funding they are all available for free to any California library user. CAreer Pathways resources can be accessed at www.southpasadenaca.gov/careerpathways.

The American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) is designed to provide much needed pandemic recovery support in the area of workforce development. ARPA funds provide free statewide availability to these online platforms through CAreer Pathways for public libraries, which allows South Pasadena Public Library to offer Coursera's more than 5,000 online classes, Skillshare's 35,000 videos, GetSetUp's interactive classes, and LinkedIn Learning's suite of courses at a savings of over \$1,000 per year per user.

Public libraries are community hubs that bring people together and close the opportunity gap by connecting people to essential services and resources. The resources available at the South Pasadena Public Library such as the <u>Job Information Collection</u> (JIC), Friends of the South Pasadena Public Library-funded <u>Tutor.com</u>, the state-provided <u>Brainfuse's JobNow/VetNow</u>, and now the CAreer Pathways collection, are just some ways in which libraries aid in personal economic development, build and encourage communities of lifelong learners, increase digital equity, and support the information needs of a 21st Century society.
